MAPLES FARM PARK COMMISSION

The winter months and Zoom meetings did not hamper the Maples Farm Park Commission from moving forward with the ambitious plan to construct a 24' x 36' open air pavilion in the area of the popular Bozrah Farmers Market field. The project initiated with a proposed gazebo structure, brought forth by Jonathan Gilman, but quickly morphed into the more diverse usage pavilion. Many members of our community who have heard of this project have offered their assistance which will be coordinated by Glenn Pianka and the rest of the Maples Farm Park Commission. Groundbreaking and the installation of the concrete portion of the project will be between the Mothers' Day Market, set for May 8th, and the official opening date of the Bozrah Farmers' Market on Friday July 9th. The building portion will commence after the close of the Farmers Market in October and be completed before winter. The Bozrah Light and Power Company/Groton Public Utilities has donated \$7,500 of seed money to jumpstart the project, expected to cost \$35-42,000. No taxpayer dollars will be utilized to accomplish this endeavor. Donors are encouraged to send contributions to Maples Farm Park Commission c/o Bozrah Town Hall 1 River Road, Bozrah, CT 06334. A memorial/contributor donor Walkway Brick Campaign is in the formative stages. All contributors will be publicly acknowledged during the building dedication to be announced at a future date.
