ELDERLY HOMEOWNERS' CREDIT

The filing period for the Elderly and Totally Disabled Homeowners' Credit is February 1, to May 15, 2020. 2019 income limits are \$37,000 for unmarried and \$45,100 for a married couple. This includes Social Security and any other income received. Copies of your 2019 SSA-1099 and any other proof of income is required. If a Tax Return is filed, a copy of the Tax Return is also required. Applicants must have been 65 or older on December 31, 2019 or 100% Social Security disabled and must maintain their primary residence in Bozrah. Bozrah Agriculture Commission 2020 AGRICULTURE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Bozrah Agriculture Commission sponsored scholarships will be awarded to one high school senior pursuing a higher education degree in agriculture and one 9th or 10th grader with an SAE project who best meets the requirements set forth by the Commission. Award amounts made by the Commission will be in the amount of \$500.00 for one graduating senior and \$250.00 for one SAE project, (in total, two scholarships will be awarded annually).

The Commission will review and score all submitted applications. Applicant's references may be contacted by telephone or email. The Commission will interview applicants on March 24, 2020. The scholarship recipients will be notified by **May 1, 2020** by mail and formal presentation of scholarships will be made at the Lebanon Regional FFA Chapter Banquet in May 2020. Students must be a resident of Bozrah, CT to be eligible. Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors and students currently enrolled in 9th or 10th grade Vo-AG High School with an SAE project.
