EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT:

On May 12, 2021, The Federal Communications Commission launched a temporary program to help families and households struggling to afford Internet service during the COVID-19 pandemic. This new benefit will connect eligible households to jobs, critical healthcare services, virtual classrooms, and so much more. The Emergency Broadband Benefit provides a discount of up to \$50 per month toward broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers.

Eligible households can enroll through a participating broadband provider (<https://www.fcc.gov/emergency-broadband-benefit-providers>) or directly with the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) using an online (<http://getemergencybroadband.org/>) or mail in application.
