- Scott Hill Road to Lake Road
- Turn back onto Bozrah Street and head down Caroline Road
- South Road to Bishop Road, back to Bozrah St.
- Head onto Gager to go around Wahconah and Rosemarie Lane
- Back on Gager to Browning Road
- Turn onto Hickory, then Ceder
- Then we head down the hill, back up Fitchville to the Firehouse.

On May 5, 2020, Governor Ned Lamont issued an executive order N.711, delaying penalties for dog license renewals until August 1, 2020.

Please plan to renew your pet's license before August 1, 2020, to avoid any penalty fees.

State of Connecticut – Executive Order N. 711

WHEREAS, Department of Agriculture and municipalities wish to ensure that individuals can follow all recommended social distancing practices and self-quarantine guidelines which may prevent them from being able to purchase a dog license within the month of June, by **extending the start date** for the **imposition of a late fee** for obtaining a dog license this year **from July 1, 2020 to August 1, 2020.**
