## **FIRST SELECTMANS CORNER**

After many years of application to the State of Connecticut Department of Transportation I have been informed that the Bozrah Street (Route 163) crosswalk from the **Charles L. Long Sports Complex** to the parking lot across the street will get the flashing lights and pavement markings that have been requested. I will inform you of the actual start date when I receive it.

The Bozrah Transfer Station is nearing completion and I expect to reopen the Bozrah Street location on or before Saturday October 30<sup>th</sup>.
