**APPLICATION FOR RENTER'S REBATE OF ELDERLY RENTERS AND TOTALLY DISABLED PERSONS**

The deadline to file is **October 1, 2020**.

Applicant must apply on annual basis for a partial rebate of his/her rent and utility bills.

Applicant must have been 65 years of age before the end of calendar year applying and applicant must have resided in Connecticut for a one year period prior to filing an application.

Income limit for single persons is \$37,000 and \$45,000 if married. Proof of rent payments and utility payment (electric, gas, water and fuel only).
