A site walk of the Bozrah Inland Wetlands Commission was called to order by Co Chairman Charlene Lathrop at 6:00 P.M. in the office parking area of the Revelation Church 166 Bishop Road.

Regular members present: Charlene Lathrop, Chuck Mandel, Steve Brunetti, James Sipperly, and Jessica Carson.

Regular members absent: Scott Taylor

Members from the public present: Glen Pianka Selectman, and, Mr. and Mrs., Thomas Ververis, 161 Bishop Road, David Held P.E., Provost & Rovero, LLC.

Property owner Matt Grobocki, Pastor of the Revelation Church 166 Bishop Road, did not participate but was aware of the meeting.

The committee members and members of the public followed D. Held down a gravel logging road to the first area of disturbance. This was 36" culvert with four pipes one concrete and three smaller plastic pipes, with riprap along the intake, it was noted that this area is not on the plan. We proceeded to the next area where large rock has been deposited in the wetlands area from the excavation that has taken place.

D. Held was asked to provide the total area of disturbance, the calculations, as well as the new areas of disturbance; these should be added to the site plan for the next IWCC meeting Thursday September 2, 2021.
