## FIRST SELECTMAN'S CORNER

Bozrah Town Hall offices, DPW and the Transfer Station will be closed Monday, May 31, 2021 in observance of Memorial Day.

**The doors of the town hall will be unlocked on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursdays starting Tuesday, June 1.**

The town hall will remain closed to the public on Mondays to allow the paper work that needs to be submit to be prepared without interruptions. As is currently the case, Monday appointments can be made with the Town Clerk. Any person who is not fully vaccinated for COVID-19 will still need to wear a mask. A person shall be considered fully vaccinated 14 days after receiving the final recommended dose of a vaccine approved for use against COVID-19.

## MEMORIAL DAY

Bozrah American Legion Post 138 will conduct Memorial Day services on Monday, May 31, 2021, rain or shine. The day will begin at the World War I Monument at the intersection of Fitchville Road and Bozrah Street Extension at 10:00 A.M. where a wreath will be placed, then lowering of the flag to half-mast and taps will be performed by Debra Coats, Director of FMS Chorus and Band. We will then proceed to Veterans Memorial Park (opposite Bozrah Town Hall) where the American heroes who made the ultimate sacrifice in the service for our country will be honored and remembered. A wreath will be placed at the memorial and brief remarks will be made by Jim Robertson, Post 138 Commander and Bozrah First Selectman, Carl Zorn. Commander Robertson will introduce guest speaker, Jon Pierce, Veteran Employment Representative & TAPS Coordinator at Connecticut Department of Labor for New London County. At conclusion, Donald H. Casavant and his son Donald J. Casavant will lower the flag to half-mast and Debra Coats will again perform taps. This will conclude our program. Flags will be passed out to all in attendance.

## DOG REGISTRATION



Per State regulations, all Dogs must be licensed each year in the town where the dog resides. Licenses and tags are obtained in the Town Clerk's Office. **Dog licenses expire and are renewed in the month of June.** If a dog license is not acquired by June 30<sup>th</sup>, a penalty of \$1.00 will be added to each additional month the dog is not registered.

The fees are \$8.00 for neutered male and spayed female dogs and \$19.00 for male or female, NOT altered.

2. Shall the Town of Bozrah adopt proposed ordinance 2021-2 AN ORDINANCE CREATING A LICENSING PROCEDURE FOR SHORT-TERM RENTAL PROPERTIES IN THE TOWN OF BOZRAH, CONNECTICUT

1. Due to the expiration of the governor’s executive order limiting capacity at indoor meetings, there will NOT be any zoom coverage of this town meeting

The Bozrah Board of Selectmen, at a special meeting on 18 May 2021, voted to refer the actual vote on both ordinances to a referendum to be held on 11 June 2021 at the Bozrah Town Hall between the hours of 12:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Therefore, following motions to enter each ordinance onto the floor for consideration and a period of discussion on each ordinance, the moderator will adjourn this meeting to referendum. This meeting will be reconvened by the moderator at 8:30 pm on 11 June 2021 at Fields Memorial School to announce and document the voting results.
