

REGULAR MEETING  
TOWN OF BOZRAH  
INLAND WETLANDS AND CONSERVATION COMMISSION

December 1, 2016

The regular meeting of the Town of Bozrah Inland Wetlands and Conservation Commission was called to order by Chairman Scott Taylor at 7:39 P.M. in the meeting room of the Bozrah Town Hall.

Members from the public present: Richard Serra Town Planner, Tom Webber Wetlands Enforcement Officer, John Lewitz, and Mark Kehrer Executive Director Revelation Church.

1. Review and approve the minutes of the November 3, 2016 regular meeting.

E. Brown made a motion to approve the November 3, 2016 regular meeting minutes with one correction, agenda item 4 paragraph 6 should be flood hazard.

Mark Kehrer Executive Director of the Revelation Church presented a map of the project and discussed removal of the vegetation on the beach area and along the bank. Sand would be brought in to restore the beach area and fill to create a picnic area in the upper section of the area.

Dredging of Tadm Pond was also included on the permit application, which M. Kehrer discussed with the commission and decided to amend the application. The dredging of the pond was removed and will be addressed at a later date.

C. Mandel made a motion to approve the application as a not regulated maintenance activity to remove the vegetation along the shore line as reference in the Town of Bozrah Inland Wetland Regulations under 4.2.2
