As of May 19 the mask rules change but business guidelines still exist. Please read entire article.

Outdoors

- Masks not required

Indoors

- Vaccinated not required to wear masks
- Unvaccinated must continue to wear masks
- Businesses, state and local government offices and events may choose to require universal masking
- Masks will still be required in certain settings such as healthcare facilities, facilities housing vulnerable populations, public and private transit, correctional facilities, schools, and childcare

The following rules apply to all Connecticut businesses and organizations and are effective March 19, 2021. Please keep in mind that it is the cumulative effects gained from social distancing, hand washing, and mask-wearing that will continue to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Businesses should take these rules as the minimum baseline of precautions needed to protect public health in Connecticut and refer to the recommended guidance by sector listed at the bottom

I was not going to anticipate what the governor was going to come out with for town halls, so the rules for the town hall have not changed yet. **I expect to allow public access to the town hall on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursdays on June 1.** The town hall will remain closed to the public on Mondays to allow the paper work that we have to submit to be prepared without interruptions. As is currently the case if you have a real need to access records or have other urgent business at other times, contact the office directly and we will make an appointment and help you.

Caroline road from 163 to the Adelman processing center will be closed for pipe replacements on May 24th.

The electors of the Town of Bozrah and those entitled to vote at a Town Meeting are hereby warned and notified of a Special Town Meeting to be held in the Gymnasium at Fields Memorial School 8 Bozrah Street Ext. on Tuesday, 1 June 2021 at 7:00 pm. The agenda is as follows:

Consider and act on the following questions:

1. Shall the Town of Bozrah adopt proposed ordinance **2021-1 AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CEMETERY COMMISSION FOR THE TOWN OF BOZRAH**
2. Shall the Town of Bozrah adopt proposed ordinance **2021-2 AN ORDINANCE CREATING A LICENSING PROCEDURE FOR SHORT-TERM RENTAL PROPERTIES IN THE TOWN OF BOZRAH, CONNECTICUT**

Copies of the proposed ordinances are available at Town Hall during normal business hours.

NOTE:

1. Due to the expiration of the governor's executive order limiting capacity at indoor meetings, there will NOT be any zoom coverage of this town meeting.
2. Social distancing and wearing of a face covering will still be required.
3. The Bozrah Board of Selectmen, at a special meeting on 18 May 2021, voted to refer the actual vote on both ordinances to a referendum to be held on 11 June 2021 at the Bozrah Town Hall between the hours of 12:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Therefore, following motions to enter each ordinance onto the floor for consideration and a period of discussion on each ordinance, the moderator will adjourn this meeting to referendum. This meeting will be reconvened by the moderator at 8:30 pm on 11 June 2021 at Fields Memorial School to announce and document the voting results.
4. Absentee ballot applications are available at the Town Hall during normal business hours.
