APRIL 2021 SENIOR REPORT

-All attending seniors have been fully vaccinated. We are still doing temp checks and following all the safety precautions.

-Our attendance has been increasing. We even have a new member! About 8-9 seniors attend each Friday. We have been playing a game called Left, Right, Center. This is a great game because it keeps the brain working and gets them a little more active. There is a lot of razzing and fun with this game. We have also been playing their favorite game bingo again, now that we are getting enough people to play. Throw away cards and each senior has their own bingo dabber.

We all enjoy each other's company and we are truly "a family" there. For each birthday we celebrate with their favorite dessert. We have taken a trip to drive by seniors houses that haven't been able to attend to wish them a happy birthday. This has made their day. We have plans to do this again towards the end of May.

-I was given a nice compliment from the seniors last Friday. Now that other centers have begun to open they have visited them and said that the Bozrah Senior Center is where they feel most comfortable and they feel safe. They mentioned the cleanliness and how everything looks so nice and new. That the paper bingo papers are great and they aren't reusing the other bingo cards. I'm so happy they are happy. Their safety is number one! Thank you to the DPW guys for all their hard work getting the center to where it is now. More improvements are needed, but it's so much better than it was.

-I have been working a lot and receive multiple calls as municipal agent from seniors in town looking for different resources from tax help, food box programs, people needing wheelchairs, and help getting them rides. If I don't know of certain resources I always refer them to Senior Resources. They are a wonderful agency that can guide them to the right place or help them themselves. They are my go to if I have questions as well.

-I am happy to report that there will be no fees charged again this year for the Dial-A-Ride program. Normally a \$24/per year fee is collected. Funding has made this possible. That being said I do have a new Bozrah Senior that has signed up for the program.
