FIRST SELECTMAN'S CORNER

The town hall remains closed to general public access to reduce the exposure of employees and public. Only one person at a time is allowed in the Tax Collector, Town Clerk or Assessor's office. You will have to stand outside or wait in your car until you're told to come inside. We appreciate your cooperation.

The playscapes and basketball courts are open at both the school and rec field. Surfaces are not disinfected so use at your own risk. Maintain social distancing where possible.

The food bank is available to Bozrah residents. Call in your needs to the town hall before 3 p.m. Thursday. Pick up is available at the town hall after 3 p.m.

There have been quite the crowds at the Bozrah Street Extension bridge. Jump at your own risk. A reminder that there is no parking on the bridge or its approaches..

We are looking for a new Transfer Station Attendant. Anyone interested should call the town hall and set up an interview. The requirements are being physically fit, capable of operating a backhoe and willing to challenge people dumping off bulky waste items and not paying.

The transfer station will be closed on Wednesdays until we find a new attendant.

DPW is working on the rec field track. to keep the track from flooding. We will also restore the surface with stone dust. If you are a regular walker on this track please be patient it will be done in the next couple of weeks.

Recently there has been a lot of trash and debris discarded on the town roads. There are also a lot of the nips and beer cans thrown out which no one appreciates. Please stop this and throw it out when you get home.

TAXES

The tax bills are in the mail. The mil rate was set at 27.0 which is a reduction of ½ mil. If you have or expect to have trouble paying your taxes the first thing to do is to contact Nancy Renshaw the Tax Collector and discuss it with her. The tax collector works Tuesday thru Thursday. Taxes are due August 3, 2020.
