- 5) **Public Comment-** Raymond Barber questioned why the special meetings of the Board of selectman was called during the day. Selectman Zorn provided that the meeting was called during the day to fit into the many meetings held, so that the budget would be approved to present to the Board of Finance on the 23rd. With the next BOS meeting on the 17th it is too close together to be sure it would be approved. Ray Barber also commented that the salary for the Zoning enforcement officer was excessive and asked that we hire a better assessor that could assess private property more accurately and bring in more taxes.
