## TAX COLLECTOR

**The Tax Office will be open:**

**Saturday, January 30th from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and**

**Monday, February 1st from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.**

If possible, please use the Drop Box, outside the Town Hall, (the box is locked and checked daily) or mail your payments to Tax Collector, Town of Bozrah, 1 River Rd, 06334. Include a self-addressed stamped envelope for your receipt return.

## ELDERLY HOMEOWNERS' CREDIT

It is time to apply for the Elderly & Disabled Homeowners' Credit.

To qualify for the homeowners' credit, the applicant must have been 65 years old as of December 31, 2020 or totally disabled. Income limits including social security are \$37,600 for single and \$45,800 for married.

The filing period is February 1<sup>st</sup> to May 15, 2021.

The applicant must show proof of income, including 2020 social security SSA-1099 statement and Income Tax return for 2020. If not filing an income tax return, all other income must be provided. Because of the corona virus, applicants are not required to come to the assessor's office to apply. You can mail, fax, or e-mail copies of your 2020, 1099 social security statement and income tax return to the town hall.
