## ELDERLY HOMEOWNERS' CREDIT

Per Governor Lamont's Executive Order No. 10, dated February 4, 2021, he has suspended reapplication filing requirements for the additional veterans tax relief program and suspension of reapplication of the Homeowners' - Elderly/Disabled credit programs. This means that if this was the year you were to reapply for either of these programs, you don't have to submit any paperwork. You will receive the same as last year.

If, however, you are applying for the very first time for either of these programs, you will need to meet the following requirements and submit the necessary documentation.

To qualify for the homeowners' credit, the applicant must have been 65 years old as of December 31, 2020 or totally disabled. Income limits including social security are \$37,600 for single and \$45,800 for married.

The filing period is February 1<sup>st</sup> to May 15, 2021.

The applicant must show proof of income, including 2020 social security SSA-1099 statement and Income Tax return for 2020 if one is filed. If not filing an income tax return, all other income must be provided. Because of the corona virus, applicants are not required to come to the assessor's office to apply. You can mail, fax, or e-mail copies of your 2020, 1099 social security statement and income tax return to the town hall.
