

2021 AGRICULTURE SPONSORSHIP APPLICATION



The Bozrah Agriculture Commission sponsorship is awarded annually to one high school senior pursuing a higher education degree in agriculture and one 9th or 10th grader with an SAE project who best meets the requirements as decided by the Commission. Sponsorship amounts will be made in the amount of \$500.00 for one graduating senior and \$250.00 for one SAE project.

The Commission will review and score all submitted applications. Applicant's references will be contacted. The Commission will interview applicants at their March 2021 business meeting. The sponsorship recipients will be notified by May 1, 2021 with a formal presentation of sponsorship awards made at the annual Lebanon Regional FFA Chapter Banquet. Applicants must be a resident of Bozrah, CT to be eligible. Sponsorships are open to graduating high school seniors pursuing a career in agriculture and 9th/10th grade students who are enrolled in a high school Agricultural Education Program.

Applications must be returned by: March 1, 2021 with all supporting documentation.
