Calling hours will be held from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 22, at Church and Allen Funeral Home in Norwich. The funeral service will be at 12:30 p.m. A reception in honor of Carl will follow at the Bozrah Moose Lodge.

The Burial, in Bozrah Rural Cemetery, with full Military Honors will be held at another date.

FIRST SELECTMAN'S CORNER

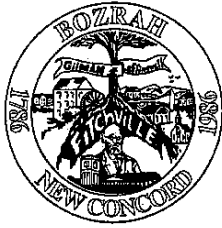

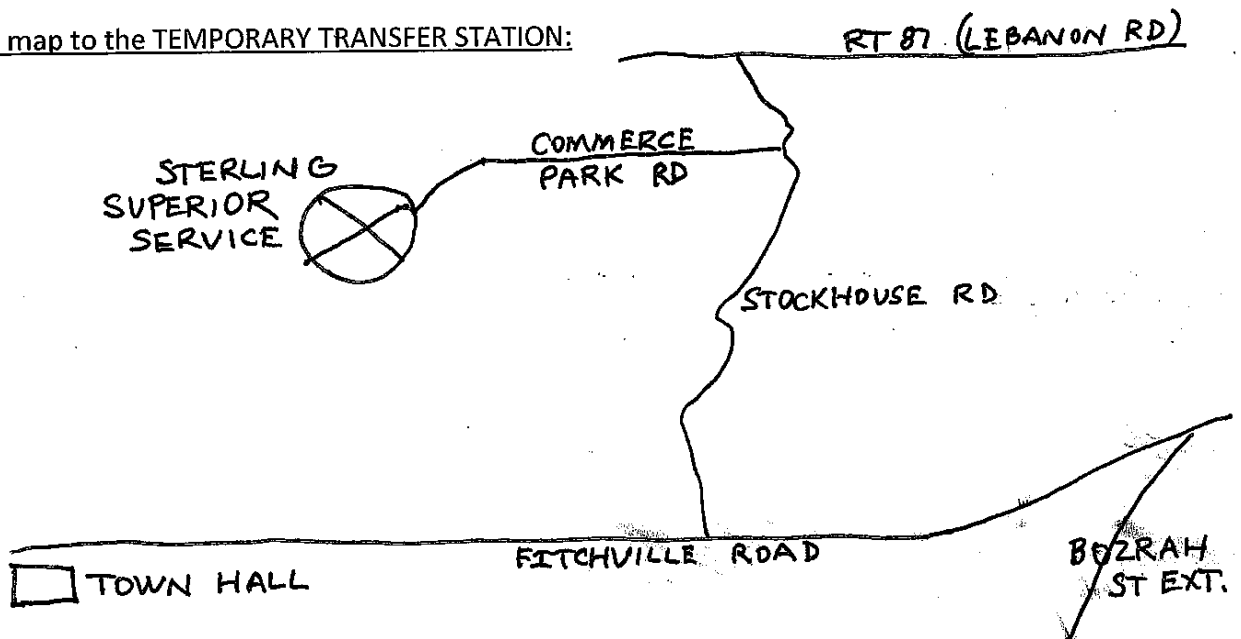
TRANSFER STATION INFORMATION

Upgrading and renovations work has commenced at the Transfer Station site on Bozrah Street. Due to the extent of the work it has become necessary to **TEMPORARILY** move the intake facility to the **STERLING SUPERIOR SERVICE** site on **COMMERCE PARK ROAD** which is off of Stockhouse Road in the Village of Fitchville.

Transfer station attendants will be on site there to direct you through your drop off. **All regular materials EXCEPT BRUSH AND LEAVES will be accepted there.** This arrangement will begin on Monday August 23 and will be open during the normal Transfer Station hours. The work is expected to be completed by September 30th.

We understand that this is an inconvenience. We tried to operate with dumpsters moved into the parking area at the Transfer Station but hazardous conditions and liability concerns prompted this necessary action. It will also speed up the reconstruction process to not have to worry about our citizens navigating around the equipment and materials that will be utilized on site.
